Microsoft Windows

- Six floppy disks from Ireland
- CD-ROM device
- Universal printer driver
- TCP/IP built-in

STPI

- India had no mainframes
- Mainframes in USA were under-utilized during India's day-time
- Software could be “sent” over the wire
- The “birth” of Indian software services industry
- Measurement is built into the system

Sulabh Sauchalay

- Much before “SaaS” was invented Dr. Bindeshwar Pathak invented “toilet” as “pay per use”
- Toilet design (saves water, gets Carbon credit, no compromise in sanitation levels)
- 2009 Stockholm Water Prize (Nobel Prize on environmental issues)
- Operates in 50+ countries

Early days @ IIT-Bangalore

- 1999 vintage
 - Laptop for every student
 - Wi-Fi in Library
 - IEEE Digital Library subscription
 - Huawei's first 45 days in India

PayTM

- Mobile Wallet
- Intuitive interface
- Integrated “passbook”
- Imaginative “marketing” PayTM *karo*
- Leveraged de-monetization to the hilt (when ALL ATM’s stopped!)
- 200 Million wallets
- 5 Million addition per day in Nov-Dec!

TravelKhana

- 11,000 pairs of long-distance trains (other than sub-urban trains) every day; 22 million people travel every day
- There is so much variety and we “love food”
- Intuitive interface
- IRCTC, Web Services, API, Mobile phones and now PayTM, UPI, BHIM ... all make it so viable
